- Representing the club at away days for our officials, management team as well as liaise with opponent club officials & match officials on the day.

- Sending Referee marks via FA database
- Attending training as and when the manager or his team need me (Registering new players or advising as needed).
- Being on call to meet a player to register him.
- Organising and attending Pitch Inspections.

I have represented the club at various Isthmian League and FAAGMs, Forum's Webinars, Ground Grading Inspections etc. I have swept leaves, cut weeds, fixed fencing and been a barman as well.
